This year's Sainsbury's Active Kids vouchers will be available to collect from all Sainsbury's stores, petrol




stations and when ordering groceries online, between Wednesday 28th January and Tuesday 5th May 2015.

All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 can have a lunch provided free under the UIFSM Government Scheme. Children in Years 3, 4 and 5 can have a lunch at a cost of £2.30 per day.

Nursery children who are staying all day or coming for the afternoon session can also order a lunch at a cost of £2.30.

ALLERGEN ADVICE

If you have any concerns about the ingredients in any of the meals, we have a list of ingredients and possible allergens within the office, please feel free to pop in and see us. If you require a "special dietary allergy meal" we also have request forms in the office.

Please note that the meals are all nut free.

NUT ALLERGY ALERT

We have a child in school that has a <u>severe</u> allergic reaction to nuts. Please be aware of what goes into your child's lunchbox and please try not to put in anything which obviously contains nuts. This includes cereal bars.



Please also reinforce to your child that he/she should not share their lunch with other children. Thank you

NURSERY PLACES

If you have younger children who you are considering sending to our Nursery it would be really helpful for us if you could complete a registration form. This means we can let you know about Nursery trial days as your child's entry into Nursery approaches and we can also plan for the numbers of children we can expect.

Registering your child for Nursery does not commit you to accept a place. Places are available from the start of the term in which your child turns 3 years old and are funded by the Government from the term after your child's third birthday.

Registration forms are available from the school office.

Our Nursery class is open every morning from 9am – 12pm and Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday afternoons from 12pm to 3pm.

This is for the safety of all the children, including yours! PLEASE KEEP OUR CHILDREN SAFE.


