A reminder that next week, July 6th is the last week for school run clubs. Premier sports and cheerleading continue the following week. Outdoor sports finished on Thursday this week.


A reminder too that school finishes at 1.30 on Wednesday 22nd July.

BAG2SCHOOL


Next textile collection will be Wednesday 12th November.
