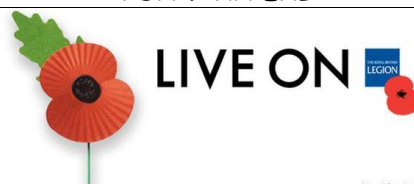

The important dates for the process are as follows:

16/01/17	<b>DEADLINE!</b> This is the latest date to submit your online application (Buckinghamshire residents only); you have until 3pm. If you are posting your application it must reach Buckinghamshire County Council by 3pm
29/01/17	<b>DEADLINE!</b> The latest date for moving into or within Buckinghamshire (and providing evidence that you are resident) for us to use this address for the first round of allocations. Final date for agreed special cases to be considered as timely (moving house is not considered to be a special case).
18/04/17	If you have applied online you can login to see which school your child has been offered. You will also receive an email.

## EMERGENCY CASCADE

You will be contacted by a member of staff who will advise what the situation is.
