- Income based Employment and Support Allowance
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child tax credit and no working tax credit with an income of less than £16,190
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

### FOOTSTEPS VOLUNTEERS WE NEED YOU!!




Footsteps is a road safety training programme for young children It helps children to learn to think for themselves and gradually get better as dealing with roads and traffic. We are

looking for volunteers to train as Footsteps tutors with the Transport Strategy Team at Bucks County Council. The course lasts up to  $1\frac{1}{2}$  hours and takes place County Hall, Walton Street, Aylesbury and training sessions are 10am until 12noon. The next training session available will be at the start of next term in January. Once trained, tutors are then able to take the children into the local area to observe the traffic and discuss road safety, through a series of practical exercises.
