**STARTING SCHOOL FOR THE FIRST TIME**

**Application deadline is 3pm 15 January 2018**

**WAS YOUR CHILD BORN BETWEEN 1 SEPTEMBER 2013 AND 31 AUGUST 2014?**

If yes, Buckinghamshire parents can apply online for a school place from 6 November 2017. Visit our website [www.buckscc.gov.uk](http://www.buckscc.gov.uk) to apply for a school place.

You must apply even if your child is at the nursery attached to the school you would like them to go to.

Helpful information about starting school for the first time is in the 'Starting School and Moving to Junior School' guide for parents which will be available on the web from the end of October.

If you cannot apply online you can fill out a paper application form.

**PLEASE DO NOT MISS THIS IMPORTANT DEADLINE**



The information about applying for your child's Reception class place for September 2018 has been distributed by Buckinghamshire County Council and is also available via their website [www.buckscc.gov.uk](http://www.buckscc.gov.uk).

The important dates for the process are as follows:

- 6 Nov 2017** From this date you can make your primary school application (Buckinghamshire residents only).
- 12 Jan 2018** **DEADLINE!**  
This is the latest date for returning a paper application to your child's current infant school if you are making an application to transfer to junior school.
- 15 Jan 2018** **DEADLINE!**  
This is the latest date to submit your online application (Buckinghamshire residents only), you have until 3pm. If you are posting your application it must reach us by 3pm on this date.
- 29 Jan 2018** **DEADLINE!**  
The latest date for moving into or within Buckinghamshire (and providing evidence that you are resident) for us to use this address for the first round of allocations. Final date for agreed special cases to be considered as timely (moving house is not considered to be a special case).
- 16 Apr 2018** If you applied online you can login to see which school we have offered your child. You will also get an email.

## DATA COLLECTION SHEETS

We are still waiting for a few Data Collection Sheets. If you haven't yet returned yours please would you do so as soon as possible.

It is extremely important that we have the correct contact details so we can get hold of you in an emergency. Please also check the numbers of any alternative contact such as childminders or family friends.

Please also check your child's medical information as this may have changed since you originally advised us of any medical conditions or medications.
