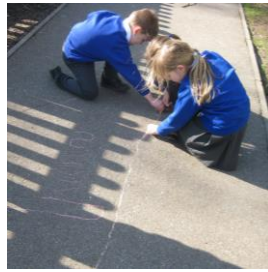

A free hot lunch is available to every child in Reception and Year 1 and 2. This is funded by the Government's

Universal Infant Free School Meal (UIFSM) scheme. Children in Nursery and Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 can order a meal at a cost of £2.40 per day.

In the case of a child's absence, a credit note is issued from the second day of absence.

THE GIVING MACHINE

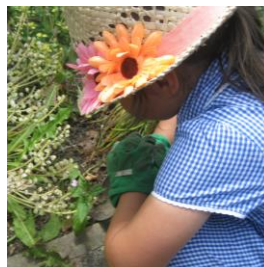
