Dear Parents/Carers,

We have had such a busy start to the new school year with many more things planned. The diary dates can be found at the end of this newsletter. By now you should have received your curriculum letter outlining the main themes of learning this term. If you have any queries please talk to your child's class teacher.

Today the children and staff have come to school wearing jeans as we support the charity 'Genetic Disorder UK' with their annual 'Jeans for Genes' day. The children have spent time this past week learning about the charity and some of the work they do. The total amount raised will be announced in our next Newsletter. If you are a UK taxpayer then there is a Gift Aid Form for you to fill out in the school office. This means that the government will donate an additional 25%.

This week the PTFA held their annual AGM. As many of you already know, members of the current committee stepped down after many years of service. It is with sadness that no one came forward to fulfil the vacant positions, therefore without a Chair and a Treasurer the PTFA cannot continue. I would like to thank all the committee members for their time, commitment and organisational skills over the past years. Many thanks also to those of you who have helped out at many events and fundraising activities. Over the last year the PTFA has raised an amazing £10,206 which will provide many additional things for the children which the school budget just will not stretch to. If you are interested in lending a helping hand or finding out more about the roles on a PTFA Committee, please come and talk to us in school.

Just to keep you updated with our school improvement programme, one of our big investments over the summer holiday was the installation of a new wifi network throughout the school. This is part of our development of ICT and is the first step in our long term technology plans.

On Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> October it is our annual school Open Day. This is an opportunity for prospective parents to tour the school, see our children working and meet with staff and governors. If you have friends or relatives whose children are due to start school or nursery next September, please spread the word.

Lastly we are always keen to welcome offers of help or support in school. Tasks include listening to children read, supporting Outdoor Learning on Monday afternoons, gardening, the list is endless. Please come and speak to your child's class teacher if you are interested in volunteering in school on a regular or casual basis.

**29 Jan 2019** Buckinghamshire (and providing evidence that you are resident) for us to use this address for the first round of allocations. Final date for agreed special cases to be considered as timely (moving house is not considered to be a special case).

**16 Apr 2019** If you applied online you can login to see which school has been offered to your child. You will also get an email. Letters will be posted to paper applicants.
