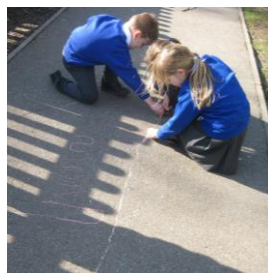

## RECEPTION CLASS ADMISSIONS

The important dates for the process are as follows:

- 5 Nov 2018** From this date you can make your primary school application. Primary Portal opens at 11.00am. (Buckinghamshire residents only).
- 11 Jan 2019** DEADLINE! This is the latest date for returning a paper application to your child's current infant school if you are making an application to transfer to junior school. To be received by 9.00am.
- 15 Jan 2019** DEADLINE! This is the latest date to submit your online application (Buckinghamshire residents only), you have until 3pm. If you are posting your application it must reach us by 3pm on this date.
- 16 Apr 2019** National Primary Allocation Day. If you applied online you can login to see which school has been offered to your child. You will also get an email. Letters will be posted to paper applicants.

### BOTTLE TOPS WANTED!

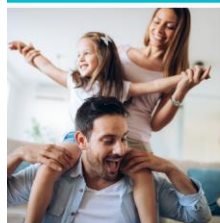
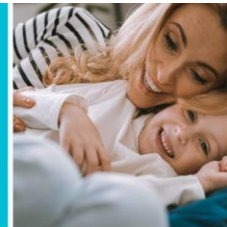

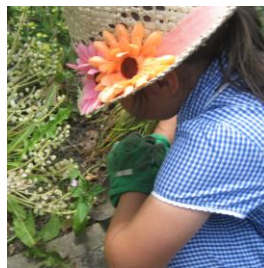
duvets and pillows in the bins. Please let your friends and neighbours know that the bins are there and that they support both our school and Starlight
