Twyford C of E School Covid-19 Home School Agreement, June 2020



SCHOOL

The school aims to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the Covid-19 infection.
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can.
- Provide a curriculum that supports your child, including their well-being and mental health.
- Contact parents/carers immediately if your child displays symptoms of Covid-19.
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' has a confirmed case of Covid-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative.
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the behaviour policy as well as upholding additional expectations as set out in the Covid-19 Behaviour Addendum.
- Communicate between home and school through email, Class Dojo, Tapestry, the school website and notices.

PARENT / CARER

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- I will check my child for symptoms each morning.
- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of Covid-19, I will not send them to school and self isolate for 14 days or until we receive a negative test result. I will let the school know the results as soon as possible via telephone.
- If my child shows symptoms of Covid-19 at school, I will collect my child from school **immediately**.
- When dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules.
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child.
- I will teach my child the symptoms of coronavirus so they can tell an adult if they have them.
- My child will only bring a water bottle, a lunch box (if required), and any other item specified by their teacher.
- My child will not bring any other items into school with them or take items home from school.
- I will ensure my child has a suitable sunhat and has sun cream applied before they arrive at school (when required).
- I will remind my child about social distancing rules but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child and other children may not always do this successfully.
- My child will know how to use good respiratory and hand hygiene.
- I will not enter the school (classroom or main entrance) without a prearranged appointment; make appointments via telephone or email.
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis.
- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home.
- I will inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carer and emergency contacts details.
- If my child is deemed unsafe, they will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.
- We, as a family, will continue to uphold strict social distancing measures at all times to reduce the risk of bringing the infection into school.

PUPIL

I will follow the rules set out in the 'Covid-19 Behaviour Addendum':

Ready Safe Respectful

I will also:

- Tell an adult if I feel unwell.
- Only bring into the classroom my water bottle, lunch box and items my teacher has told me to.
- Not take things home from school.
- Use only my equipment and not share my equipment with others.
- Only enter and exit the school building from the designated entrance and follow the routines we have set up.
- Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it, bin it, kill it) and avoiding touching my mouth, nose and hands.
- Follow good hand hygiene use soap and water for 20 seconds/hand sanitiser.
- Only enter the toilet if there is no one else in there.
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others.
- Not cough, spit at or sneeze towards others.
- Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
