PARKING

Several of our older children now walk to school unaccompanied and we must all work together to ensure that they, and all our children, are safe during their journey.

WATER BOTTLES

Could all children please have a water bottle in class. As the weather gets warmer it is important that the children have access to a drink during the day. We do not have drinking water in the classrooms so it is essential that we have a water bottle available which we can refill from the drinking water supply in the kitchen as necessary.

There are a few water bottles available to purchase from the school office at a cost of £1.50.

CHILDCARE VOUCHERS
