Please also reinforce to your child that he/she should not share their lunch with other children. Thank you


#### SCHOOL UNIFORM

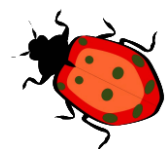
