The teachers then had inset to support them in how to take this further to enable children to become learners in their own right. We will be continuing with this as a staff and embedding it within our school to ensure the children become independent in their learning and lives and more resilient in their effort to achieve.

Year 3 and 4 will be having a student working with them over this term. Miss Leslie will be supporting Miss Steer in her final teaching practice before becoming a fully qualified teacher. She visited the children on Wednesday and was very keen to get to know everyone and start work. We all look forward to working with her over the next few weeks.

Next week we have a Shakespeare day when "Perform" are joining us. All children will experience a drama and literacy day based around "Midsummer Nights Dream". Please note also the production of Midsummer Nights Dream at Claydon House in July which is mentioned later in the newsletter. KS2 are continuing the theme for the whole week to link with their Tudor topic.

In school we are having a real push on spelling and reading. Both are crucially interlinked and therefore support one another. We would appreciate it if you too will help your child at home by ensuring your child/children read to you, or another adult every single day. This has such an impact on all their learning and opens up a whole new world. This includes all of KS2 as well. Spellings also need to be practiced daily for <u>all</u> children. All of this will only take 20 minutes of your time but will give your child such a fantastic advantage in their learning.

We will be having a book sale of our ex library books next Friday 8th May. Children can bring in money to buy a couple of books over the day. The sale will be at break and lunchtime. Money raised will go towards replacing and enhancing the selection in the library.

As the weather is improving, please could you ensure your childs name is clearly written in their jumpers and cardigans. Five minutes at the end of every break and lunchtime trying to find the correct owners, equates to 10 minutes a day, five days a week which is fifty minutes of learning time wasted. This is on top of the money it costs for you to replace lost clothing.
