Dear Parents

Welcome back to everyone. I hope you all had a wonderful Summer and a good rest.

We would like to welcome Miss Chilton and Mrs Wiese to our staff team. Both will be working in Reception, Miss Chilton as the class teacher and Mrs Wiese as the LSA alongside Mrs Eldridge.

We would also like to welcome, Kim Cannon and Isabelle Seago to Year 3 and Lucy Jones to Year 5. We also warmly welcome Rudi Cannon to Reception and Gwilym Walters, Ava Hennessey, Keir Gurney, Adam King and Chloe Wheeler to our Nursery class as they start their school career.

The staff have been very busy over the holidays preparing the classrooms and learning activities for the children. We know it's going to be a very exciting year with lots of fantastic opportunities for learning. Our September Inset for all staff was based on Growth Mindset training. Staff looked at ways of praising children and encouraging them to develop the mindset which will allow them to flourish. Much of the ethos revolves around children's resilience and determination to persevere at a task, no matter how difficult. Intelligence is not fixed and therefore children need to understand how to develop their love of learning and achieve their very best through effort, motivation, perseverance and support. We will be having a curriculum evening this term which will include a section on growth Mindset which I hope many of you will attend to learn how you too can help your child.

Please remember to park considerately when dropping your child off and picking them up. Do not block driveways and pavements and please park as far away from school as possible and walk the rest of the way. Please do not park in the staff car park at anytime. This is for your child's safety.

Reception, Nursery and Key Stage 1 children must have plimsolls in school for P.E. Key Stage 2, Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 need to have trainers for their PE lessons. All children will need these throughout the school year.

All children will receive new Reading Record Books, Spelling Books and Learning Logs. Please could you ensure that all old books, letters etc. from last year are removed from their bookbags/rucksacks in order to fit the new books in and avoid any confusion.

Staff aim to send out their topic letters next week when they have added the learning ideas from the children.

Next week our Year 6 take the 11+ assessment which is now known as Transfer Testing. Please try not to focus too much on this as they will not perform their best if they are stressed.

We are all looking forward to another happy and successful year here at Twyford. If you have any concerns or just need explanations of things please do not hesitate to speak to either me or my staff.
