Dear Parents

At the end of last week, all children helped to put together a mosaic which will go around the blackboard at the front of the school. It looked lovely when I last saw it and we all look forward to seeing the finished design. Thank you to Katie Ellison for organising it all.

The children had a talk from the PCSO about Stranger Danger last week. If you are chatting to your child, do reiterate the message of not speaking to strangers no matter how nice they may appear!

In conjunction with Marsh Gibbon Tennis Club, tennis coaching has started again, as last year on a Friday afternoon. Key Stage 1 and then Key Stage 2 in July. The children thoroughly enjoy the tennis and hopefully will continue to practise it at home.

Yesterday Key Stage 1 had a great day at Green Dragon Rare Breeds Farm. They started their visit looking at all the different animals, including feeding the goats and lambs. The children also spent time in the walled garden looking at everything being grown and then picked strawberries for the chef to use in the restaurant. After lunch they went into the orchard for a mini-beast hunt. All the children behaved very well and had a lovely day.

Jake E was also awarded "Best Player" for his performance in the Hockey team.

Next week is a very busy week in school. On Wednesday we will have our Musical Extravaganza where children will perform on the piano, recorders or singing groups. You are welcome to join us for this from 9.30am.

Both Key Stage 2 classes have theatre trips to see Incredible Invaders and Groovy Greeks, whilst Year 2 are off to the Small Schools Sports Festival at Stoke Mandeville. Foundation, not to be left out, have their Grandparents Afternoon on 30th June.




