## Dear Parents

As you know from previous communications, the Governors and I have been looking at Academisation for some time. This is following the Government's decision to encourage all schools to become academies by 2022. We have looked at various models and invited lead schools and Buckinghamshire County Council to put forward their proposals. After much due diligence we have decided to look more closely at the Oxford Diocese option which appears to support the ethos and values which are central to us at Twyford School. We are now in discussions about next steps and what this will look like for us.

There will be a consultation and a meeting for parents in the near future to explain and answer any questions you may have about Academisation. Please feel free to ask myself or any of the governors anything you feel unsure about in the meantime and we will try to answer. We will, of course, keep you updated with any developments as we move forward.

We have a Paediatric First Aid course taking place at school on 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> June. CDW First Aid Training are running the sessions and they are offering parents the opportunity to attend the course for £85.00 for the two day course. This is very competitive compared to other paediatric first aid courses which are normally over £150. If you are interested please let me know as soon as possible.

We are looking forward to seeing everyone at our annual Cream Tea next Friday. Hopefully the sun will shine and it will be a lovely afternoon for parents, grandparents, friends and family. Teas are served from 2.00pm onwards.

## REMINDER - WARWICK CASTLE

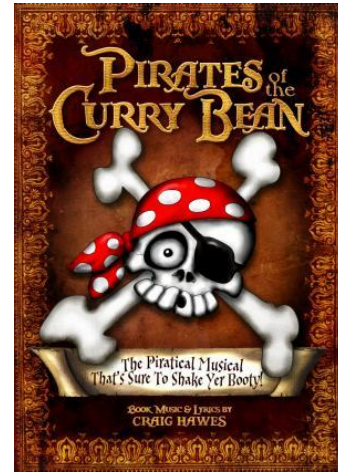
## INSET DAY

## NURSERY CLASS - 30 HOUR FUNDING OFFER

From September 2017 the Government are introducing 30 hours of free childcare to working parents. The additional 15 hours is available for families where both parents are working (or the sole parent is working in a lone-parent family), and meet certain criteria related to the hours of work and income.

The Department for Education eligibility checking tool <https://www.childcarechoices.gov.uk> can be used to check your entitlement to the additional funding. You can check now but will need to recheck during August to enable you to access the extra funding in September 2017. Once you have checked your eligibility you will be issued with a **code** which you will need to pass onto us so we can claim the funding on your behalf.
