Dear Parents,

Well, that was a bit of a start to the New Year! Ofsted arrived on Thursday to inspect the school as they do every 3 to 4 years. I am not allowed to divulge any outcomes yet, apart from we were pleased with the result. A report will come out in a couple of weeks which you will then be able to read. Thank you so much to all those who made such positive comments to the Ofsted questionnaire, or to the Inspector. He told me a few comments and they were lovely and it demonstrated how proud and loyal you are to the school and staff so thank you.

The 11+ went smoothly and the children took it all in their stride. Results come out in a few weeks.

You should have received your class topic letter by now, so you will know what areas your child will be covering this term. The teachers have planned exciting experiences or visits which can be enhanced by research and chats at home.

Please would you not park opposite the zigzag lines outside school. A couple of cars have been parking opposite which is firstly illegal and also means the bus cannot reverse properly into the drive.

Music lessons are up and running again, but we will lose them if they are not supported well. Individual drumming and guitar lessons occur on a Monday and Tuesday. 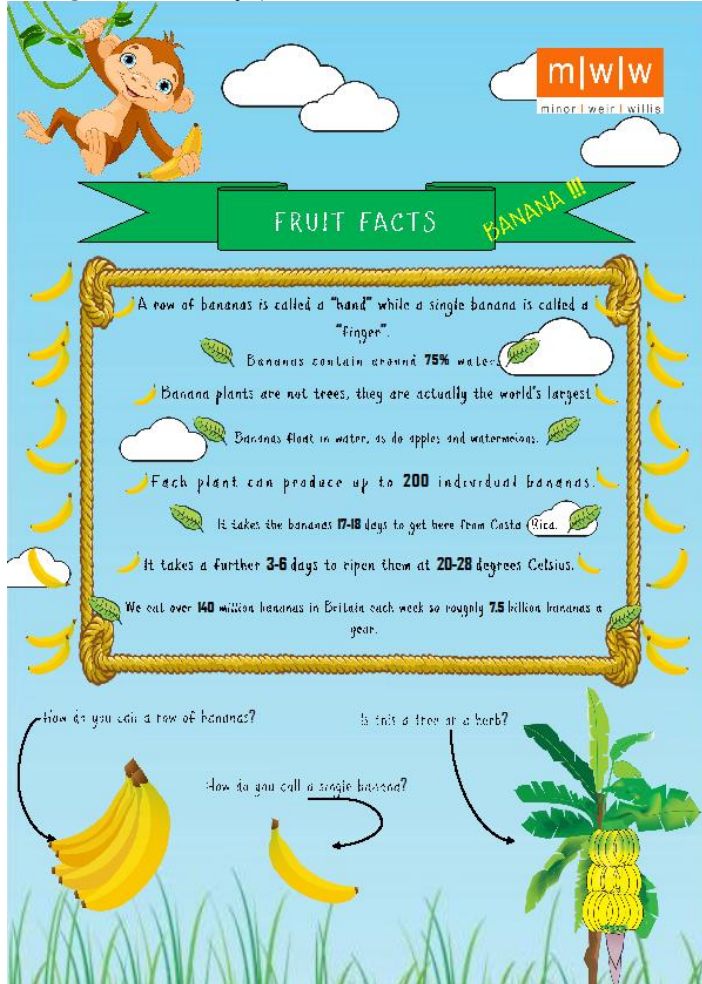

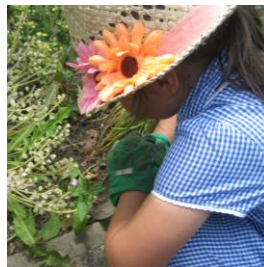
### STARLIGHT CLOTHING BINS
