This is a reminder that online applications for Reception Class places for September 2018 must be made no later than 3pm on 15 January 2018.

Information about applying for your child's Reception class place for September 2018 is available on the Buckinghamshire County Council's website www.buckscc.gov.uk. The Christmas Holiday might be an ideal time to make the application, try not to leave it until the last minute.

DEADLINE!

 ${f 15~Jan}$ This is the latest date to submit your online application 2018 (Buckinghamshire residents only), you have until 3pm. If you are posting your application it must reach us by 3pm

on this date.

DEADLINE!

The latest date for moving into or within Buckinghamshire 29 Jan (and providing evidence that you are resident) for us to 2018 use this address for the first round of allocations. Final date for agreed special cases to be considered as timely (moving house is not considered to be a special case).

16 Apr If you applied online you can login to see which school we 2018 have offered your child. You will also get an email.
