I thank you all as parents for your support and belief in me as your child's Headteacher and I wish every one of you all the best for the future.



#### HOT LUNCHES

Chartwells, our hot lunch suppliers, have now informed us that the cost of a lunch will now be increasing at the start of next term rather than after half-term. The new price will be £2.40 per meal.

You should have all received the new Hot Lunch Order Form for next half-term in book bags, along with a copy of the menu. A copy is also available to download from the school website and a menu is at the end of this Newsletter. Please return orders by 9am on <u>Tuesday</u> for the following week. If possible please order for the whole half term.



A free hot lunch is available to every child in Reception and Year 1 and 2. This is funded by the Government's Universal Infant Free School Meal (UIFSM) scheme. Children in Nursery and Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 can order a meal at a cost of £2.40 per day.

If you need to cancel your child's lunches due to illness or would like to discuss allergen information or anything else related to the hot meal service please call Chartwells Customer Care Line on 01908 615705. In the case of a child's absence, a credit note is issued from the second day of absence.
