There have been a number of jumpers and sweatshirts going missing recently. With the Summer *nearly* here, please can you ensure that all uniform is named. Children will take their

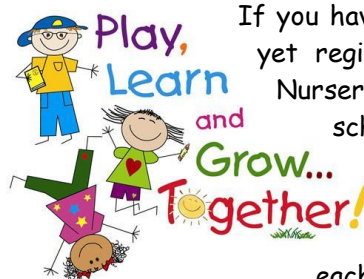

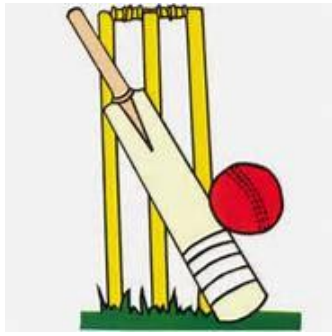

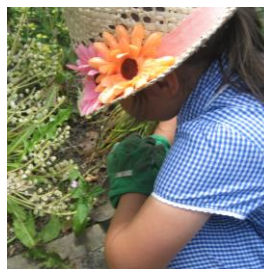
