Dear Parents/Carers,

It has been a very busy couple of weeks in school and we very quickly seem to be hurtling towards the summer holidays. NEARLY NEW UNIFORM

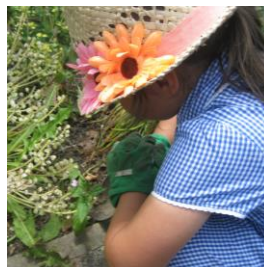
