# A letter from our Chair of Governors

Dear Parents

The 2018-19 academic year is now well underway and the Governors wish Judith Bloomfield and her new staff team great success in the coming year. The Governing body is preparing for its first main meeting of the year on Tuesday 6th November, and in preparation the following tasks are in process.

1/ Finalising our committee teams with which Governors will be part of our four sub-committees, where all the detailed main work for the governing body is undertaken. These are:

Finance, Personnel & Premises

Curriculum & Policies

PR & Foundation and Welfare

Health & Safety

This term we have been joined by two new Staff Governors, Michael Burrige and Dominique White, who will be assigned committee roles.

2/ The School Development Plan (SDP) & 3 year Strategic Plan is in process of completion. These documents are based on school targets as well as other items highlighted in the July Collegiate workshop meeting, which collaboratively involved Teachers, Governors, PTFA and local clergy. The plan is continually reviewed and monitored through the school year.

3/ During the Spring term 2019 the school will have a SIAMS Inspection by the Church/Diocese and we are currently preparing for this. Work has already started on this reviewing the School Vision & Values. The goal posts have changed dramatically since our last inspection and schools can no longer be graded 'Outstanding'. It is predicted that the majority of schools will now be 'Good' under the new framework.

4/ GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) - whilst all necessary data controls are in place between the school, county and relevant suppliers, we still need to finalise our formal policies and confirm to our stakeholders.

5/ The Headteacher and all staff will have performance objectives set for the coming year. This needs to be overseen by the Governors who have particular responsibility to agree those for the Headteacher and confidentially monitor these during the school year.

6/ Finances - whilst the school is currently in a positive position financially, we can never be complacent! The Finance, Personnel & Premises committee continually monitor spends vs budget in conjunction with Judith & Julie Hall the School Business Manager. We also aim to keep an open mind on reconsidering academisation should financial impacts change and make it more cost effective and attractive to the school.

Hopefully this gives you a good perspective on the current Governor activity.

Finally, as I mentioned in my update speech at the Celebration assembly in July, Succession Planning is a topic for the Governing Body that can never be ignored. As you will appreciate it is a constant challenge as the Governing Body membership and experience levels change over time.

To try and mitigate such changes, the governing body is keen to encourage Parents, Grandparents, local village or catchment area residents that may have a link with the school or are just interested in getting involved, to come forward and express an interest to join the Governing Body.

This can be achieved by joining the Governors as an Associate for a period of 1 or 2 years, so you are able to learn more about what is required and get involved. This is a way of strengthening the governing body, spreading workloads and getting more people active than just the 12 formal members.

Associate Governors have the same inputs and responsibilities as a full governing body member - indeed the only difference is that if there is a formal vote needed on a Finance or Personnel matter they are not able to vote, a rare event at Twyford. Associate Governors are also more likely to fill full Governing Body positions when they arise, if they wish to and if the vacancy is applicable.

Therefore PLEASE if anyone is interested in becoming an Associate Governor, just let me know your details either via the school office directly or by using their email address [office@twyford.bucks.sch.uk](mailto:office@twyford.bucks.sch.uk) Ideally it would be great if you could do so before 6<sup>th</sup> November, so you would be able to attend the Full Governing Body meeting that evening if possible.

## STARLIGHT CLOTHING BINS

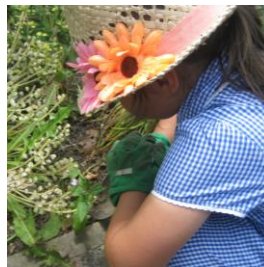
