Covid-19 Behaviour Policy Addendum



As we welcome you back to school, we are sharing three new behaviour values that will make it a safe and caring experience for us all.

Ready
Safe
Respectful

Ready

Ready usually means being on time, with the right equipment and ready to learn in every lesson.

When we come back **ready** will also mean –

- Staying 2m away from each other as you walk to school and as you enter the school grounds.
- Waiting calmly for the school doors to open staying 2m away from each other.
- Coming into school calmly through your designated door and washing hands using the sanitiser provided.
- Dressed sensibly in our school uniform (in PE uniform when needed and wearing trainers we can exercise in).
- Bringing in a full water bottle (with water inside, not juice).
- Having a packed lunch where you can open all the packets on your own.
- Only bring in things your teacher has told you to. Leave everything else at home.

Safe

Being **safe** would normally be walking around the school sensibly and playing positive games at playtime and lunchtimes.

When we come back, being **safe** is our priority and will also mean –

- Keeping our distance from other people.
- Only using the stationery and equipment given to us by our teacher and not sharing it with other people.
- Staying in our seats during lessons.
- Using tissues for coughs and sneezes. Putting tissues in the lidded bin as soon as you've used them.
- Following the designated routes around the school and following the rules about only one child in the toilet at a time.
- Making sure we wash our hands thoroughly for the recommended 20 seconds.
- Following the instructions of all staff during the day and especially at playtimes and lunchtimes.

- Following all rules and instructions at all times so we are all safe.

Respectful

Having **respect** for each other is something you do really well. We display this in our body language, our actions and how we talk to each other.

When we come back, that **respect** is even more important because it shows we care about each other's feelings –

- Be considerate about each other's feelings – some of us may be worried or upset.
- Encouraging each other in our work with positive comments.
- Listening to each other if we want to share our ideas or how we feel.
- If we're worried about ourselves or our friends, sharing that with an adult.
- Listening to adults and being considerate about the feelings of the adults supporting us.
- Trying our best in every activity.
- Being kind to each other as we enter and leave the school site.
- Following all rules and instructions at all times to show your respect to all adults.
