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Starting school for the first time

Was your child born between 1 September 2019 and 31 August 2020?

If yes, Buckinghamshire parents can apply online for a school place from 1 November 2023. Visit **buckinghamshire.gov.uk/schools-and-learning** /schools-index/school-admissions to apply.

You must apply even if your child is at the nursery attached to the school you would like them to go to.

The application deadline is 15 January 2024, please do not miss it
