Phonics and Reading in Reception

This term Reception children will begin to learn the initial phase 2 letter sounds and begin to develop skills of blending to read CVC words e.g. c-a-t. They will be given their first reading book towards the end of this half term. At Twyford School reading is so very important to us and we urge you to support your child's reading skills by sharing their reading book with them every day. Please record each read in their reading record. For every day that a child reads at home it will be recorded on a bookmark in school and awards will be given throughout the year to those pupils who achieve 50, 100, 150 and 250 reads at home!

These will be available to borrow from our Nursery and Reception class lending libraries. The children will receive their own bookmark with the full list of books for this year.
